**God loves you, and He wants to give you a gift - eternal life. He wants you to have a personal relationship with Him.**

## You have to enter the Kingdom of God to receive the gift.

The Bible talks about the Kingdom of God and the kingdom of darkness. To receive the gift of God and truly experience God and know Him personally, you must enter the Kingdom of God.

You enter the Kingdom of God the same way as you would enter a country. How? By crossing the border. That's why it's important to know what you need to do to enter the Kingdom of God.

## Your sin separates you from God.

Because of sin you cannot enter the Kingdom of God.

### What is sin?

The Bible says, *“For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God’s glorious standard.”*

Romans 3:23

Jesus says, *“And when He comes, He will convict the world of its sin, and of God’s righteousness, and of the coming judgment. The world’s sin is that it refuses to believe in Me.”*

John 16:8-9

## What is sin basically?

Basically, sin is not what you say or do, but the fact that you do not believe in God.

Sin is simply missing the mark, even if you don't think you have fallen short of God's standards. A more serious situation is that you know you have fallen short of God's standards and you do not make a decision to follow Him. The worst case scenario is that you know you have fallen short of God's standards and you completely reject Him.

Without faith in God, you have missed the mark – this is sin.

## What are the consequences of you living in sin?

The Bible says, *"The wages of sin is death."*  
Romans 6:23

The Bible talks of eternal damnation, and the consequence of sin is eternal death, eternal separation from God. If you leave this life without believing in Jesus, there is no guarantee what will become of you.

## **The way to the Kingdom of God and to receiving the gift of God is believing in Jesus.**

The Bible says, *“But God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.”*

Romans 5:8

Furthermore, the Bible says, *“Christ suffered for our sins once for all time. He never sinned, but He died for sinners to bring you safely home to God.”*

1 Peter 3:18

Jesus died instead of you, and He is the only way to God.

## God said, there is only one way to the Father in Heaven.

Jesus told him, *"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through Me."*

John 14:6

When Jesus walked on this earth, He talked about God being our Father. God has given you a way to Him through His own Son, Jesus, who died on the cross in your place for your sins.

He rose from the dead and because of this fact you can come to know God as your Father, receive forgiveness for your sins and live a life full of meaning and love.

## To become a child of God you must take a positive step of faith and accept Jesus.

The Bible says, *“But to all who believed Him and accepted Him, He gave the right to become children of God.”*

John 1:12

Receiving Jesus, taking part in the gift of God and thereby entering the Kingdom of God is simple. The Bible is God’s manual to you, and all you need to do is follow the guidelines.

## **When you confess your faith in Jesus, you enter the Kingdom of God, are saved and become a child of God.**

The Bible says, *“If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”* Romans 10:9

Furthermore, the Bible says, *“For “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”* Romans 10:13

Receiving Jesus implies you acknowledge to God that you have sinned and are turning away from sin. You must believe that God forgives all your sins through the death and resurrection of Jesus. You choose to believe in Jesus and to follow Him as your Lord.

## You must pray to God and receive Jesus.

Prayer is talking to God. If you wish to receive the gift of God and sincerely believe in your heart and decide that you want Jesus to be Lord of your life, you can pray the following prayer. Pray aloud as a confession, and God will hear your prayer.

**Jesus, I receive you as Lord of my life. I believe in You with all my heart. I believe You died for my sins and You rose again. From now on You will be Lord of my life. Thank you. I am now a child of God and have received eternal life.**

## **Congratulations, you have crossed the border to the Kingdom of God and you are now a child of God.**

Now, everything in the Kingdom of God belongs to you. You have received Jesus and have become a child of God. God wants you to know Him. He wants fellowship with you and desires to help you in any way. You come to know God through reading the Bible and receiving teaching in a church. Through prayer you talk to God, and your new life with God will grow day by day. You will also realise that God has a fantastic plan for your life.

## **You are a child of God – you are also an heir of God.**

The Bible consists of two testaments, the Old and the New Testaments. When Jesus died on the Cross, the children of God gained access to all the treasures, blessings and promises of God – also called ‘the inheritance’. ## Loving God is what the Christian life is really all about.

What does loving someone mean? You want to be with the one you love, talk to him or her, come to know this person and develop a close relationship to him or her. If you love God you will listen to Him and talk to Him.

When you realise and understand God's Will for you, you will begin to practice it in your life.

Spend time every day talking to God.  
Praying to Him is as simple as talking to a  
good friend on a cell-phone. Your choice of  
words is not important.

you need, and thank him for all He has done.”*  
Philippians 4:6

God wants you to talk to Him, telling Him  
what is on your heart. He is your closest  
friend. He will listen to you when you pray  
to Him. Nothing is too small and nothing is  
too big to pray for.

## Take part in Christian fellowship.

Go to church regularly to a place where Jesus is worshipped through prayer and singing and where you can receive teaching from the Bible.
